

QM Quartz – Care & Maintenance Guide

Everyday Cleaning

- Use a soft cloth or non-abrasive sponge with warm water and a mild dish soap.
- Avoid harsh chemicals, acidic cleaners (like vinegar or lemon), or bleach-based products.
- For dried spills, gently scrape with a plastic spatula and wipe clean.

Stain Prevention

- While QM Quartz is non-porous and stain-resistant, it's best to clean up spills quickly—especially from coffee, wine, oils, or coloured liquids.
- Use a pH-neutral surface cleaner for added protection if needed.

Heat Protection

- QM Quartz is heat resistant but not heatproof.
- Always use trivets or heat pads under hot pots, pans, and appliances to avoid thermal shock or discolouration.

Scratch Resistance

- Quartz is highly scratch-resistant but not scratch-proof.
- Avoid using knives directly on the surface—always use a chopping board.
- Do not slide heavy or rough-bottomed objects across the surface.

Avoid Harsh Chemicals

- Do not use products containing bleach, ammonia, paint strippers, oven cleaners, or nail polish remover.
- If exposed accidentally, rinse immediately with water.

Sealing

- QM Quartz surfaces do not require sealing, unlike natural stone. Its non-porous surface is built to stay low-maintenance and hygienic.

Long-Term Care

- For deep cleaning, use a gentle, non-abrasive quartz cleaner recommended for engineered stone.
